Treasurer's Report-

Joan Mabe reported a balance as of January 9 of \$12,780.22 and of \$15,917.62 as of February 13th.

Special Guest – Mike Lyons

Mike asked the club for ideas for any spring programs we would like to see happen at RIZ. The club would like to see some stroking classes start up for skaters. Mike also asked for other ideas or classes we would like to see happen at the rink during the summer months. The club will brainstorm some ideas and get back to him.

There has been a change in the morning freestyle schedule to accommodate both Kathleen and the rink's interests. The rink will continue to be open three mornings, but will open slightly later one day as Mike will be opening instead of Kathleen.

Test Session

A test session was held at RIZ on Thursday, February 9. During this session, there were some issues that arose. At one point, the session was about 35 minutes ahead of schedule. This left some of the skaters feeling rushed and unnecessarily stressed. It was decided that future test sessions should run as close to schedule as possible and would not be allowed to get more than 20 minutes ahead. The club's desire is to serve the skaters and make them feel at ease when they test. It was also decided that at future test sessions, there will be one member of the test committee designated to be in charge of the session in case any issues arise. This position can be rotated within the test committee. Communication is the KEY to a successful test session.

Governing Council-

The 2012 Governing Council is being held at Myrtle Beach, South Carolina on May 4-5. The club is allotted 2 delegates for the meeting. Sue Sondej and Joan Mabe have volunteered to be the CVSC delegates.

Skater Recognition Banquet-

The banquet has tentatively been scheduled for April 28 or 29. There is no other new information at this time.

Used Equipment Sale-

The Used Equipment sale that was held on January 21 went very well. The club made about \$120.

Jump Harness-

Diane was contacted by Juli Davi, Richmond FSC President, about merging the 2 clubs together. This is being discussed and will be researched further.
