**Minutes**

A motion was made to approve the old minutes from the February meeting. A second was made and the minutes were approved by consensus.

**Treasurer's Report**

As of March 8, the balance in the account is \$14,571.34. The need to file for non-profit status was discussed.

## **Club Membership**

There was a motion to accept Nicole Moriconi for membership. A second was made and approved by consensus.

## **Test Session**

The test session that was held on February 25 went very well. There was concern that there is always a lot of extra food left over after test sessions. For the next test session hospitality will have a more specific list of food items needed and will be asking volunteers to bring them. Hopefully this will help cut down on the leftovers. The club made some money on this test session. The tentative schedule for the next few test sessions is: RFSC next 2 sessions (April / June '10) and CVSC in August '10.

## **Miscellaneous**

### **Skate Sale-**

The used equipment consignment sale was held at RIZ on Saturday, February 13. The sale went very well with total sales of \$1,070. The club made about \$238 on the sale.

### **Governing Council-**

Governing Council will be meeting on April 30-May 1 at the Hilton Orange County/Costa Mesa in Costa Mesa, CA. CVSC is allowed to have 2 delegates attend Governing Council. Diane Brown is still able to attend, but, unfortunately, Susie Vaughn has had something come up and will not be able to attend.. It was decided that Diane will attend alone and Susie will give her proxy to Diane. Diane will be splitting the cost of car rental with the Richmond FSC delegates.

### **Storage Shed-**

The club needs to have additional space for storing items like paper products, production props, and tables. The club would like to purchase a storage shed to be placed behind the Icezone. The cost for a shed would be around \$800 including the shed and flooring. A motion was made to release \$800 to purchase a shed. A second was made and approved by consensus. Before purchasing the shed, the club will need to ask Mike for approval for the club to install a shed in the back parking lot of the rink. Joan will also do some research on having shelving inside the shed.

### **Skater Recognition Banquet –**

The banquet is scheduled for May 22 at the Charter Colony club house. There is a \$150 fee to rent the club house. The club will also need to put down a \$250 deposit which will be returned after the event is held. A save the date notice for this event will be sent out to members soon. A formal invitation will be sent out to the members at a later time. Skaters will be recognized for their skating accomplishments from this year at the banquet. A form for skaters to report their accomplishments will be sent along with the invitations. A separate letter will be sent out to the coaches and the coaches will be asked to sign off on the skaters' accomplishment forms. The seniors will be recognized at the banquet. Gold pins will be presented to all club members (current and former) who have earned them since the club formed. Other skaters will be provided with information about purchasing patches or pins to recognize their own test accomplishments. The club will be paying for the skaters & coaches to attend the banquet. The banquet will be catered.

Club Emails to members-

Diane Brown will now be in charge of maintaining the club email list and sending out the club emails.

Skate 4 Babies-

The date for Skate for Babies is Saturday, June 5. More details for this event will be sent out soon..

Club Newsletter-

Deb Ulmer has agreed to head up the club newsletter. Many skaters and coaches also used this time to work on new skills and preparing for the February test session.
